Genesis Avalon: Patriot, Episode 23: “The Revolution Will Be Live”

[theme music ends]

(On the roof of the Gazette building, Old Gods have arrived to confront those who would rob them of their power.)

NINURTA

We will water our fields with your *blood!*

TUNANNU

Do you have any idea how much hard work, how much careful planning went into this? And you've got the unmitigated hubris to think you can stop us?

REVOLUTION

It's easy to posture when you're the one holding your boot to someone's neck. But, that doesn't make me fear you. The spirit of revolution exists to stand up against tyrants like you. Not just kings or emperors. Any one man who thinks he is above all others.

TUNANNU

I *am* above you, you insignificant little turd! I am Tunannu, The Leviathan! The Devourer of the worthy! And this is MY DOMAIN! I am no king, I am **God!**

KERRI

You're a thug! A murderer! You're no god. you're a bloody animal and the whole world is about to know it -

TUNANNU

Come here!

(Tunannu yanks Kerri to him with a demonic, tentacle-like arm.)

LEO

(choked) LET HER GO!

(Leo musters up the strength and power to slash at him and cut Tunannu's arm off, drops to the ground and swings his blade clean.)

TUNANNU

(Roars in pain) Ninurta! Get the Celtic bastard!

(Ninurta kicks up a rush of wind as he prepares his attack)

NINURTA

A knight against a god? (laughs) Quaint. Let us see how your blade handles against a true, holy weapon..

(Ninurta swings his scythe and Leo's sword connect with a mighty clash)

TUNANNU

(meanwhile, has resecured his hold on Kerri, gloating but *pissed*) What do you possibly think you could do to me, you little gnat? (long sniff) Ah, that's what this is. I never realized I had someone from the royal family here. You gonna go tell on me to your big, bad brother the king?

KERRI

(talking, through him choking her) I don't.. have...to...

TUNANNU

What? Sorry, can't hear you. Someone seems to be choking you.

REVOLUTION

Smile. You're on camera.

(He turns on his phone so it's recording, and it goes to the jumbotron below. We can hear a slight reverb as it's being broadcast to the busy square below, as well as on every TV in the nation.)

REVOLUTION

Anything you'd like to say to your adoring public, Vice President Tom Connors?

TUNANNU

Huh Catch.

(Tunannu throws Kerri off the roof. Her scream dopplars away as she falls fast)

REVOLUTION

KERRI, HANG ON!

(Patriot power-up as he sprints towards her, but Tunannu grabs him.)

REVOLUTION

No!

(Kerri's screams fall away, but then... the skies darken and there's a burst of thunder and wind.)

GENESIS AVALON

EPONA, SAVE HER!

(The spell takes effect and Epona's horses crash past them and surround Kerri. Genesis Avalon swoops past.)

TUNANNU
DAMMIT!

(Exodus lands on the roof with a crack of concrete and lightning.)

TUNANNU
Oh, Sammy boy, a trooper to the bitter end. Camulus isn't gonna be enough this time around. I don't think you can even turn on a light bulb with the pittance of power he'd let you have.

EXODUS AVALON
He's not the only god of thunder. *TARANIS!*

(Exodus channels the power of Taranis and sends a thunder clap BOOMING Tunannu and Ben. Tunannu is nearly blown off the roof, digging tentacles into the building.)

TUNANNU
(growls) You think a little fall will kill me?

REVOLUTION
Maybe not the fall, but I bet you won't like the landing!

(Ben powers up.)

REVOLUTION
Let's find out!

(WHAM, Revolution redirects them into the side of the building and sends them both to the ground.)

REVOLUTION
(In between punches) You! Don't! Scare! Me! Revolution! will! Happen!

TUNANNU
Revolutions only delay the inevitable! You'll die like the insect you are!

REVOLUTION
YOU FIRST!

(BAM, they crater into the ground amidst screams and panic. As the smoke clears, Ben has the invulnerability shield sound that Patriot did.)

REVOLUTION
(quiet as he dusts himself off) I can't believe that worked... I'm bulletproof now, too?

(Epona's horses ride by and drop Kerri off and Avalon lands beside them)

GENESIS AVALON

Kerri, are you okay?

KERRI

I... I am. But... Julian... he...

GENESIS AVALON

I felt it happen. But we didn't know until we were almost here. Kerri... I'm Sorry-

KERRI

No. This isn't on you. (turns to Tunannu, quiet rage) It's on *him*.

TUNANNU

(Roars as he rears up, a true monster)

GENESIS AVALON

Okay, screw this Cthulhu crap. Revolution, we can't punch our way out of this one.

REVOLUTION

We don't have to. He needs worship to survive. The public know Tom Connors is... this thing. They saw it happen live. It won't convince everyone. But it will convince enough. We just need to wait for him to burn through his reserves. (beat) Also, I'm fine, by the way. I also fell off the building.

GENESIS AVALON

I know. But, I knew you'd be fine.

REVOLUTION

How?

GENESIS AVALON

The same way I know Sam needs to stay up there with Leo: I know when my family is in danger.

TUNANNU

SHUT UP! DON'T YOU EVER **SHUT UP**. You are nothing! You are a washed up, mouthy bitch, just like your goddess and yet again, I have to do *everything* myself because not even that dog Calhoun could finish the damn job!

GENESIS AVALON

I killed the son of Balor. You'll be no different!

TUNANNU

You think Obsidian had power? (laughs) Let me show you 'Power', Genesis Avalon. Behold; **TRUE HUNGER!** Behold the true void of the Devourer!

GENESIS AVALON: PATRIOT EPISODE 23 “The Revolution Will Be Live”

(Tunannu opens a hell month, trying to draw people into it)

GENESIS AVALON

DRUANTIA, PLANT ME TO THIS HALLOWED GROUND! I ORDAIN THIS SPACE MOST HOLY!

(Vines snap into the ground and wrap around her ankles as a woman screams and is ripped away into the void.)

GENESIS AVALON

Hold onto me!!

(They grab onto her.)

REVOLUTION

NO! (shouting over the wind) He's gonna kill everyone in Times Square!

GENESIS AVALON

No, he's NOT! SHIELD!!

(Thinking fast, she pulls her shield.)

KERRI

Your shield can't protect us forever!

GENESIS AVALON

Not on my own... but I'm not alone. I'm not favored of one goddess, but all. *MORRIGAN!! I SUMMON YOU NOW! I ACCEPT THE DUTY OF SACRED MOTHER! MACHA, GODDESS OF THE BATTLE FIELD! GIFT ME NO SHIELD, BUT A FORTRESS!!*

(Insane burst of magic as the shield expands into a holy wall of magic, muting the sound of the void behind them.)

REVOLUTION

(cries out as he's swept away during the spell)

KERRI

BEN!! Jaina, we have to get him! (when she doesn't answer) Jaina?!

GENESIS AVALON

(grunting with effort, holding the spell in place. And the Morrigan) I see with the eye of the raven... I see with the eye of the raven... I see with the eye of the raven...

KERRI

No... Nonono, Morrigan! Let her go! *Jaina!*

(Back on the roof of the Gazette building, Ninurta and Leo are locked in a pitched battle. Leo lets out a pained grunt as his sword is knocked away and he drops to his knees, exhausted.)

LEO

Ah.... nuts...

NINURTA

Feel satisfied with your life, mortal. You fought your best. Know you will rest in your land of heroes tonight. For now... you shall be reaped.

(Ninurta swings his scythe, but with a crack of lightning, Exodus is there and clashes swords with him.)

EXODUS AVALON

Dagda!

(Sam powers up, tackling into Ninurta to drive the fallen harvest god back.)

EXODUS AVALON

Farm god turned warmonger? That's sad. Shouldn't you understand more than anyone that seasons change? Your season's over, mate!

NINURTA

You fool. I am a god of life and death. I am no season. I am the very cycle itself.

EXODUS AVALON

So then you should know when you're beaten!

NINURTA

Careful what you say, avatar of Dagda... After all... What is winter but the retreat of those crops that will rise taller than ever in the spring?

(Ninurta opens a portal and disappears)

LEO

(sounds so sick and weak) Really? What a bag of hot air... he didn't even leave any good bye henchmen... (As he starts to pass out) Oh no...

EXODUS AVALON

Dammit, Leo!

(Sam grabs Leo and pulls him close)

EXODUS AVALON

Stay awake, you bloody pain in the arse.

LEO

(out of it) Tim's gonna be pissed I dropped my sword... Oh.... Gwen's gonna be pissed I didn't get home...

EXODUS AVALON

You're not dying.

LEO

Bet.

EXODUS AVALON

Just... trust me. (deep breath) *Dain Cecht... Son of Dagda, you who heal the very Tuatha... heal this knight of the once and future King of Avalon.*

(There is a shimmer of healing magic. Leo sighs in relief as he is healed, but still weak)

LEO

That... that's neat. I'm... Sam, I'm tapped...

EXODUS AVALON

I know, brother. Come on, I've got you. Also...

(Sam holds Leo's sword back out to him.)

EXODUS AVALON

Your sword, Sir Knight. Don't drop it again.

LEO

Aw, you used my sword fighting the weird guy who smelled like bread? I'm honored.

EXODUS AVALON

Glad you're still cracking jokes.

LEO

Have to. I won't be tonight, that's for sure.

EXODUS AVALON

I know. (beat) We felt Julian, but we couldn't...

LEO

We saw it happen on the jumbotron, man. It was so fast. And... if he had been saved but we'd lost Kerri...

EXODUS AVALON

Yeah.

(They hear Tunannu cast the void.)

EXODUS AVALON

We've gotta get down to the others -

(More Overseers appear around them.)

EXODUS AVALON

So much for him not leaving goodbye henchmen...

LEO

Ah, F--- Me and my big mouth...

(In Times Square, The Void of Hunger devours anything that comes near it. Revolution is ripped away from Avalon and Kerri.)

REVOLUTION

Nononono - (grunts as he barely manages to catch a light pole)

TUNANNU

(laughing) You pitiful, wretched little boy! You thought you could come for *me*? I am the Leviathan! I eat little heroes like you for breakfast!

REVOLUTION

Is that why you had to lie to the entire country? Because you're so "*powerful*"? That doesn't make you powerful, that makes you a parasite!

(The wind picks up more.)

TUNANNU

You know, it's actually kind of amazing. I don't even have to *touch* you to kill you and yet you will. not. stop. yammering. You know *why* I picked the No More Heroes party? Because it was so stupidly easy to make them hate Avalon and the rest of you! People are so scared to lose any security, they'll sacrifice anything they have to in order to feel safe. And that's what my Stewards gave them. *Safety*. They were so grateful to feel so cozy, and I could eat up that visceral worship all damn day.

(Even though he's been struggling to hold on through the onslaught, Revolution focuses for an attack. A power-up ripple effect radiates around him as Revolution holds onto the car he's caught.)

REVOLUTION

Chew on *this!*

(He hurls the car at Tunannu and there's an explosion of metal and fire as Tunannu can't stop from sucking that stupid thing down his gullet. The wind dies down, Revolution stalks closer.)

REVOLUTION

Bet that didn't taste too good, huh, "Devourer".

TUNANNU

(winded, but certainly not out of the fight) I will squish you like a bug... All of this bluster. All of this bravado, and for what? Them? They *hate* you. All of these easily led sheep, they despise you. I didn't cause that. I just gave them permission to do that! So go on, keep jabbering. They'll watch you cause all this property damage and all that will occur to them is "are my taxes going to go up?"

REVOLUTION

Who *cares* if you've told them it's okay to hate us? Hate me? Who *cares*?!

(Tunannu rears up and takes a swing. Revolution catches that tentacle and holds tight.)

REVOLUTION

You might be some ancient creature, some old god that looks like something out of Lovecraft's racist as hell books, but you know what the thing is about being a human? You said it yourself that the US does it best. We don't. Need. Gods.

(Revolution's grip tightens, and Tunannu groans in pain because WHAT THE HELL, THIS KID IS HURTING HIM)

REVOLUTION

It doesn't matter if they hate me. I believe we're better than that. We can *be* better. And it doesn't matter if I'm the *only* one who believes that. I will never *stop* believing it. And I will *always* know that about myself. You can't take that from me. And I know that does make a difference because I changed *one* person's mind today; He's out there filming the atrocities your Stewards committed. He's showing people the blood on your hands. And when they see, they will stand up too. You didn't make them stand up. You have no power! As long as one person believes that, America can be better than this. As long as one person keeps saying is and one person listens then you've already lost.

TUNANNU

(his groan is a bit more pained, weaker) Just... shut up... Shut your mouth....

REVOLUTION

You can feel it, can't you? Your control over them... it's slipping. Your tank is running on empty because they're not feeding you. Your hunger will grow more and more ravenous but it will never be satisfied. Because every time you take out one of us, even more will answer the call. And anyone who wants to climb out of the hole you've put them in can leave your hatred behind. (beat) You're no monster. You're a ghost.

TUNANNU

(desperate, winded) No... No, I had them... I *had all of them*...

GENESIS AVALON: PATRIOT EPISODE 23 “The Revolution Will Be Live”

(A bunch of cars suddenly drive onto Times Square from the various side streets, then stop around them. People open their doors and step out, answering the call to support Revolution.)

CROWD 1

Leave the hero alone!

CROWD 2

Get the hell outta here, who the hell do you think you are?! I sure as shit didn't vote for you!

CROWD 3

Your men killed that reporter! We saw what you did! We don't want you here!

(The crowd start to angrily rage and riot around them.)

REVOLUTION

You heard what the people said, Tunannu. They don't believe in you.

(Tunannu starts to power up, as if for another attack.)

TUNANNU

This isn't over... I am *not* done...

(But instead of attacking, he portals out and the crowd quiets.)

CROWD 3

Where'd he go? Man, what a wuss.

CROWD 1

Screw him, we need to clear the road for the fire trucks! Come on!

(The cars start to back off and Revolution runs over to where Avalon is still holding up the barrier.)

REVOLUTION

Avalon! Hey! It's over! You can let the barrier down!

KERRI

(muffled) I don't think she can hear us! Ben, I think the Morrigan won't let her go -

(But the barrier comes down on its own.)

KERRI

Jaina?

GENESIS AVALON

(catching her breath) I'm... I'm okay... feel like I licked a battery, but I'm okay. (deep breath) I haven't channeled that much of the Morrigan since Obsidian. I forgot what it was like to be in control of the comet, instead of just being roped to it, you know?

KERRI

(Long beat, a bit in awe and flummoxed) No... No, I have absolutely no frame of reference for that.

(Exodus Avalon flies himself and Leo down to join the others)

LEO

Guys... Guys we saw the whole thing from the roof. That was insane!

EXODUS AVALON

Halfway through that fight, the Overlords vanished. I guess he didn't have the magic left in him to sustain them.

GENESIS AVALON

Tunannu's gone.

REVOLUTION

Probably to lick his wounds. Or tentacles, I dunno, I'm really trying not to think about it. But, the important thing is... it worked. People all over the country have seen what he's done. He's losing influence and it's just gonna keep spiraling out.

KERRI

So.... so we did it. But, we know it's not that easy.

REVOLUTION

It's not. But, I believe in Casey. And between us, President Mirzaei, and the rest of the Freedom Press, I believe we've got a chance.

(Sudden bolt of lightning, then a wave portal crashes open, Manannan Mac Lir steps out)

MAC

(full Man of the Sea, regal god mode, very serious) Genesis Avalon, Priestess of the Isles, your duty has been fulfilled here. I call you home and you will *not* refuse.

GENESIS AVALON

Who...

MAC

Save your questions for later. The Lord of Annwn is moving against the Kingdom and I need my warrior priest and priestess.

GENESIS AVALON

"Your" priest and priestess? (takes a beat, then it clicks) I recognize you now... The Morrigan knows you. Manannan Mac Lir, the god of the Sea.

MAC

(dropping a bit of the bravado, but, you know, still *impressive*) Aye. About bloody time she started lettin' you talk to her like an equal. Now, follow me, I cannae keep this open for long.

GENESIS AVALON

No, wait, I have more to do here -

(Revolution clasps a hand on Genesis Avalon's shoulder)

REVOLUTION

We got this.

GENESIS AVALON

(after a moment of internal debate, looks to Ben) I'll come back if you need me. Just ask. I'm always listening.

REVOLUTION

I know. And now the rest of the world knows it, too.

GENESIS AVALON

Kerri, you should come with us -

KERRI

No, I can't. I really-- Just, tell my brother to be safe, to keep his wits about him. And smack the hell out of him for the stunt he pulled.

EXODUS AVALON

Are you sure?

KERRI

Job's not done. And Julian... he deserves a proper memorial. I have to give him that much.

MAC

If ye don't come, Jaina, there won't be much world left to protect. Arawn wants to bring the Otherworld into ours and I can feel him toying with the magical boundaries as we speak.

KERRI

Go. I'll see you soon. Promise.

(Jaina gives her a quick hug, then turns and walks through the portal with Mac, Exodus Avalon and Leo. The portal closes behind them, leaving Revolution and Kerri alone.)

KERRI

(Deep breath) What now?

REVOLUTION

Now? We go clean house.

(On the grounds of the Arthur Estate outside of London, Mac's portal crashes open and everyone walks out onto the grounds of the Arthur estate before it closes behind them.)

GENESIS AVALON

We're home...

LEO

Oh man! Travel by portal is so much better than planes! Less deep vein thrombosis, less headaches, less throwing up...

EXODUS AVALON

Manannan...

MAC

Aye. I wonder what tipped you off; the regal bearing, the impressive powers, the fantastic beard, great sense of humor. I'm just glad to see ye recognize me when ye're not just asking for my power, Sam. You're welcome, by the way. Now, repeat after me: "Mah-na-non Mac Leer" Five years ye said my name in a funny way and I still took yer bloody calls.

LEO

(Still loopy) That's really impressive and really cool and all, but I really need to sit down soon or my legs are gonna make that decision for me. Still might have a little deep vein thrombosis after all...

(Door opens as a few figures come outside.)

ALICIA

(ecstatic) *I knew it!*

EXODUS AVALON

Alicia!

ALICIA

Dad!

ROXIE

(to Genesis Avalon) Oh, you catty bitch, it's not enough you come back without telling me, you got a ride from a god?

GENESIS AVALON

Roxie!

(Hugs all around as Alicia and Roxie reach them.)

GENESIS AVALON

Is everyone all right?

ROXIE

Better than all right. Tim and Noir pulled some strings with our contacts at the BBC, they've been running the footage nonstop since you rescued the President. Tim's with the Prime Minister now.

ALICIA

Everyone's fine, I promise, and it's really good to see you. I missed you. But, why are you here?

EXODUS AVALON

You'd have to ask Manannan, he's the one who summoned us back.

ALICIA

Wait, what? Mac, you told me you were going to take Queen Medb somewhere she couldn't hurt anyone, and you brought them back?

GENESIS AVALON

(Did her apprentice just call the god of the sea by a nickname? Eyebrows up) "Mac?"

ALICIA

Uh... yeah, it's been a weird few months, I'll have to catch you up.

MAC

Aye, I brought them back. We just imprisoned Arawn's most loyal ally. He won't take that lying down. Now, all of ye. Inside. Eat something, have a chance to be with your families, rest while ye can. When he makes a move... we'll know.

(Jaina and Sam detransform.)

SAM

Come on, Leo. (pats his shoulder)

JAINA

Wait, where are you going?

SAM

We'll catch up.

(The groups part ways, just Leo and Exodus walking off.)

GENESIS AVALON: PATRIOT EPISODE 23 “The Revolution Will Be Live”

LEO

Hey, Sam, what was that about?

SAM

Well, you had to leave your family to come get me. Seems only fair... I should be the one to return you. (smirk) Brother.

LEO

(little chuckle, then realizes) Oh, I'm gonna regret this, aren't I?

(In a barren bit of farmland in Northern England, Ninurta is waiting amongst the wheat. Arawn's hellmouth opens and he steps through, hounds at the ready.)

ARAWN

I would be pleased to see you, Ninurta, but I have seen what an abominable failure your co-conspirator has made of your dominion in North America. A shame. He seemed to have... such potential.

NINURTA

Tunannu is nothing if not resilient and craven. This will not stop him. I expect he will join us shortly, once he realizes I have left the continent for this... quaint island country you're so in love with.

ARAWN

It is not love that drives me, Ninurta. It is a cold fact that this isle and all of its spoils belong to me. I was once a king of this realm, long ago, long before mortal men squabbled for parcels of land. Death conquered me, and so I conquered Death in return. And now... all of this will be mine again. Eternally.

(Tunannu's portal opens.)

TUNANNU

(stumbles out of the portal, sounding weak and almost human, like some sort of barely hidden demon in a man's shape) Those... little... deist bastards! *I'll kill'em... I'll kill'em all*

NINURTA

That took longer than I anticipated, Tunannu. Once we could sense The Dagda had joined the fray, I assumed you would know that discretion would be the better part of valor.

ARWAN

As I understand it, he never even fought The Dagda. He was bested by some New God.

TUNANNU

Oh “new god” my ass, give it a rest, will you? We would have *had them* if you had stayed to fight! I thought you were a god of war! Instead, when we finally get to the precipice of our victory, you outstandingly *shit the bed!* And now, we are losing our worshippers! I’m *starving*, we need to go back and *fix this*, Nicky. Now.

NINURTA

I am aware that your power is beginning to slip away, Tunannu. That is why I came here -

TUNANNU

Oh, I know why you came here: you came to beg Arawn for help. You idiot. Do you think *he* cares about what we want? Do you think he’ll share even an iota of power with us?

NINURTA

Oh... I.... I believe you misunderstand me, Tunannu.

(Ninurta’s scythe appears and stabs Tunannu through the chest. Tunannu gasps in pain and shock as he is run through by a holy weapon. The God-Killing kind.)

TUNANNU

What’re you...

NINURTA

Your power is slipping away, but mine does not waver so easily. And as I had no official elected position, I can simply... disappear. My name can mean something different. I can be made anew. I told you once, I refused to play second fiddle to another god. What made you think you would fare any different? So special; “The Biblical Leviathan”. Now my name... will mean everything yours doesn’t. Everyone will remember that Tom Connors was Tunannu, but no one will know that Nicholas Jones did anything wrong.

(Ninurta leans closer, twisting the scythe, making Tunannu wheeze in pain.)

NINURTA

(Whispers in his ear) I told when we first planted these seeds... I have always known this would be a temporary alliance. A single growing season. We have toiled the field together, and you have done such good work, Tunannu. But I’m afraid the world has turned and the fall has come. And we must begin the harvest.

(There’s a swell of magic as Ninurta absorbs Tunannu’s power and then the god himself. Tunannu wheezes and groans as he is devoured, first is essence then his physical form. The wind kicks up around the wheat as Ninurta embraces the new power he has. When the magical dust has settled, Ninurta sounds even more powerful and godly than he did before.)

NINURTA

Much better. Now... Lord of Annwn, I trust you have room for another god in your... new pantheon.

ARAWN

There is always a need for crops to be sown, Ninurta. And when we end The Dagda... my subjects will need a new Father to watch over them. But make no mistake... you cannot hope to betray me.

NINURTA

I have been a god of many things, Lord of Annwn. I will be whichever you do not wish to be. There are a number of titles to choose from once the Tuatha de Danaan fall to you.

ARAWN

Agreed. So then... let us begin.

(Lightning crashes and a dark, deep rumbling sounds around them.)

ARAWN

(casting an old spell, deep magic) To me, my brothers and sisters of the Aos Si. To me, the scions of death and decay, that which has been conquered and that which lie in wait for the moment of restitution. I am Death, I am the Lord of Winter, of the Night, and I am the force that moves the wheel of all things. I shall be *heeded!* ***Bring my Otherworld to this mortal plane! Avalon, you are mine!***

(The ground bursts in front of them with another hellmouth, Banshees and Wights and all manner of beasts of the otherworld come pouring out)

(On the Arthur Estate, Jaina and Roxie are sitting outside in the quiet afternoon.)

JAINA

That's a helluva story, Roxie. I have to admit, I am... so amazed by everything you can do with the Egyptian gods. That you've started to connect to them... I'm happy for you. I really am.

ROXIE

Thanks... I... (little chuckle) Honestly, I don't know if I'm ready for what comes next.

JAINA

What do you mean?

ROXIE

Nephthys... she told me that when I was done helping the King with this crisis against the Aos Si... that I would need to return to her. I think... I have to leave once this is settled.

JAINA

Leave? No, hang on, you're a Knight of the Round. You *are* of Avalon.

ROXIE

And yet... I am also not. I'm the priestess of the Night, the Nox. And I owe it to my patron to find out what that means.

(Thunder crashes and there's a swell of magic as Arawn's spell starts to take effect.)

JAINA

Roxie... are you seeing what I'm seeing?

ROXIE

It's 3 PM and the sun just disappeared.

JAINA
